## NEWS FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF DENVER

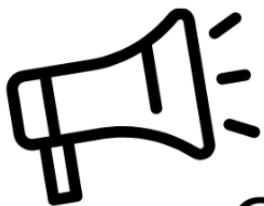
## **HIGH SCHOOL THE WORKS**
