

CONFESSION: A GUIDE

As the Father has sent me, so I send you. . . . Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained. (Jn 20:21-23)

Catholics have an obligation to go the confession at least once a year (CCC1457). If you are in mortal sin, you should not receive Holy Communion, even if you experience deep contrition, without first going to confession. Here is a guide for confession from a priest: Two things that normally get omitted in such accounts are: 1) mortal sins must be confessed according to number and kind (i.e., how many times one has committed such sins since one's last confession, and what it was), and 2) venial sins do not have to be confessed as such, but can be confessed generally. This can help one simplify one's confession (except from *Denver Catholic*).
