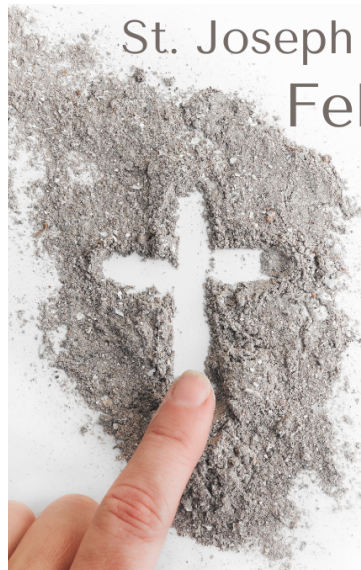

## 40DAYS FOR LIFE KICKOFF

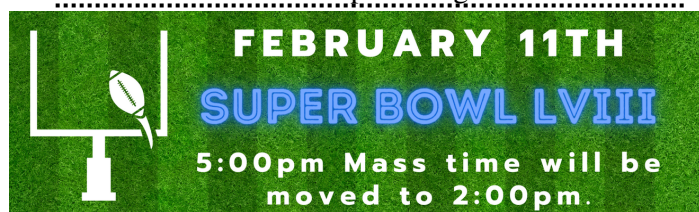

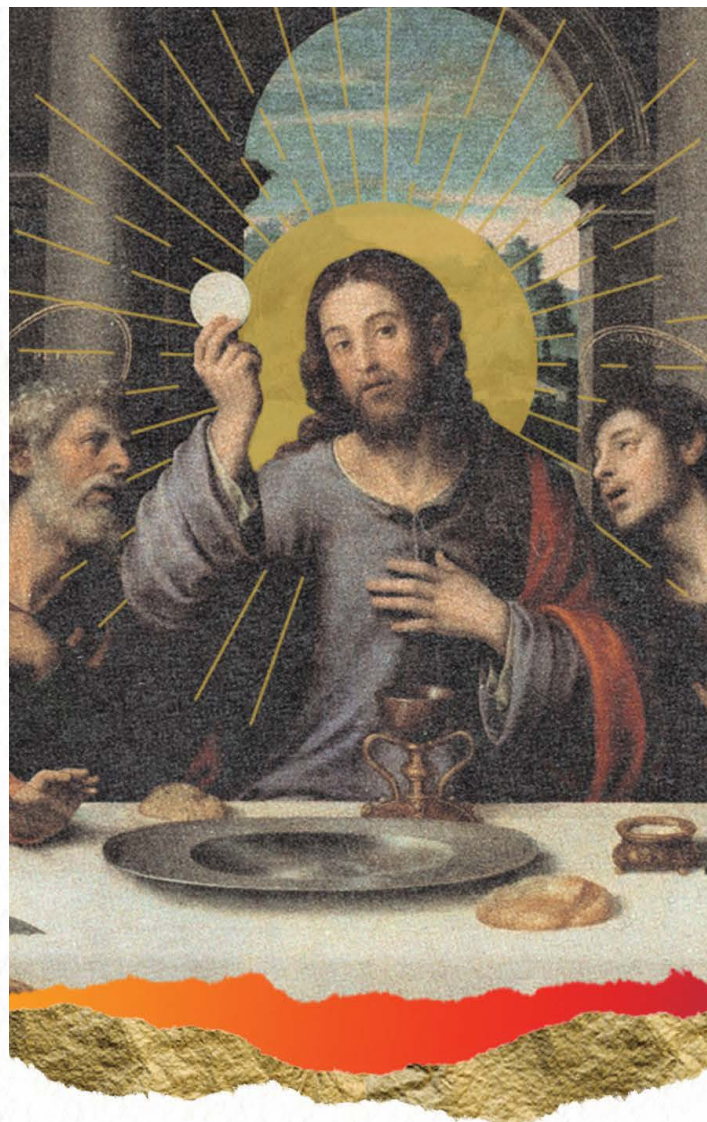


Lord Jesus Christ,
