NOTEWORTHY

4TH OF JULY PARKING

Please note that there will be one Mass on Thursday July 4th at 8:00am and no confessions or Adoration. It will be important to note that Mountain Ave will be closed for the 4th of July Parade for the City of Fort Collins. Below is the parking information they have provided us, please take note and plan accordingly.

- Mountain will be closed going westbound at Howes, so just in front of the church the road will be closed and no parking signs will be placed.
- However, cars will be able to turn North on Howes from Mountain and would be able to park or access the parking lot from there.
- There will be a sign on Howes at LaPorte that states road closed ahead, however patrons could go around it to access the church lot.
- Once in the lot you will not be able to exit onto Mountain because you will be stuck on Mountain with no exit points from Mountain.
- If you are able, you could also park on Mountain just east of Howes in any open spots (should be pretty empty at 8am).
