NOTEWORTHY

4TH OF JULY PARKING

Please note that there will be one Mass on July 4th & 5th at 8:00am and no confessions or Adoration.

It will be important to note that Mountain Ave will be closed for the 4th of July Parade for the City of Fort Collins. Below is the parking information they have provided us, please take note and plan accordingly.

- Mountain Ave will be closed going Westbound at Howes, (just in front of the church the road will be closed and no parking signs will be placed).
- Cars will be able to turn North on Howes from Mountain Ave and would be able to park or access the parking lot from there.
- There will be a sign on Howes at LaPorte that states road closed ahead, patrons can go around it to access the church lot.
- Once in the lot you, do not exit onto Mountain Ave because you will be stuck on Mountain Ave with no exit points from there.
- You can also park on Mountain Ave just east of Howes in any open spots (should be pretty empty at 8am).
