

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS DISPLAY




Join us at the Cathedral of Saint Mary in Cheyenne, WY on March 1-2, 2025. This Vatican-approved international exhibit was designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis himself. He was known for his devotion to Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions, which he catalogued on a website he designed. Carlo, an artist, cartoonist and avid computer enthusiast, created the art for the panels before his death from leukemia at age 15 in Monza, Italy. Events will start on Saturday, March 1, 2025 from 5:00pm-8:00pm and then Sunday, March 2, 2025 from 9:00am- 7:00pm. With special guest talks starting at 3:00pm.

The Vatican has provided the faithful with a Jubilee Celebration Calendar. This week, we are invited to reflect and celebrate: **Deacons**

In every parish, there are people whose service and devotion are beyond measure, whose faith shines as a guiding light for others. Among these pillars of the Church, you, the Deacons, stand as steadfast servants of Christ, faithfully dedicating your lives to the ministry of the Gospel.

As Deacons, you live the calling of service, embodying Christ's love and humility in ways that touch the lives of all who encounter you. Whether through baptisms, funerals, the preaching of the Word, or assisting our priests during Mass, you serve with deep compassion and unwavering faith. Your work, often behind the scenes, may sometimes go unnoticed, but it is never without profound impact.



