SAVE THE DATE: SUMMER FAITH FORMATION





FATHER JOE HARTMANN INVITES YOU ON A PILGRIMAGE TO THREE AMERICAN HEALING SHRINES IN WISCONSIN JUNE 18–22, 2025

From Marianne Arling: Dear Marian Friends, My dear departed husband, Deacon David, always wanted to take people on a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Champion, a healing shrine. So in memory of him, last year, with the encouragement of Bishop David Ricken - the Bishop of Green Bay who had the apparitions of the Shrine approved as worthy of belief by the Vatican - I organized a pilgrimage there. We have been honored to have a friendship with Bishop David for many years, and we know that he wants pilgrimages to go to the only American Vatican approved Marian Shrine. And so, I feel the Holy Spirit calling again for a pilgrimage to the Shrine in honor of Deacon David. The Shrine is an officially designated pilgrimage site, where plenary indulgences may be granted during this Jubilee Year. Father Joe Hartmann will accompany us with this pilgrimage. Father Joe will be praying with us and saying Mass daily with us. As the theme of this Holy Year is Hope, our prayers and meditations as we travel will be to encourage Hope. The pilgrimage has been planned for the dates June 18 through June 22. We will visit two other shrines on the trip - Holy Hill, a Marian healing shrine in Milwaukee, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. The cost is \$1,500 which includes airfare, food, lodging, and bus fare. We will stay at the Comfort Suites in Green Bay, where the Shrine has had conferences.
