

HAPPY RETIREMENT

After 52 years of dedicated service, we joyfully honor Mary Lou Lybarger as she retires from her role as Principal Organist and Choir Director at Saint Joseph Catholic Church.

Mary Lou began her ministry in August 1973, when she was hired by Monsignor John Cavanagh. In



addition to her role as Principal Organist, she served as Music Director for 18 years, beginning under the leadership of Father Philip Meredith. Her musical gifts and deep faith have shaped the spiritual life of our parish for more than five decades.

Saint Joseph has been more than her place of work—it has been her spiritual home. Here, she met and married her husband, Warren, raised their children, and honored the lives of their parents. Her commitment extended beyond our parish: she was elected to the Archdiocesan Music Committee, serving six years—three of them as Chair—and was invited to play for the Installation Mass of Archbishop José Gomez. She also lent her talents to the Abbey of Saint Walburga, playing for the Chapel's Consecration Mass and several Religious Consecrations, and even gave organ lessons to Mother Hildegard and a few of the nuns.

Though she is stepping down from her official role, Mary Lou will continue to bless us with her music from time to time—playing for weddings, funerals, or as a substitute organist. She also plans to continue assisting at Masses at Saint John XXIII.


