Mass, Marisol Health Visit, and Fellowship

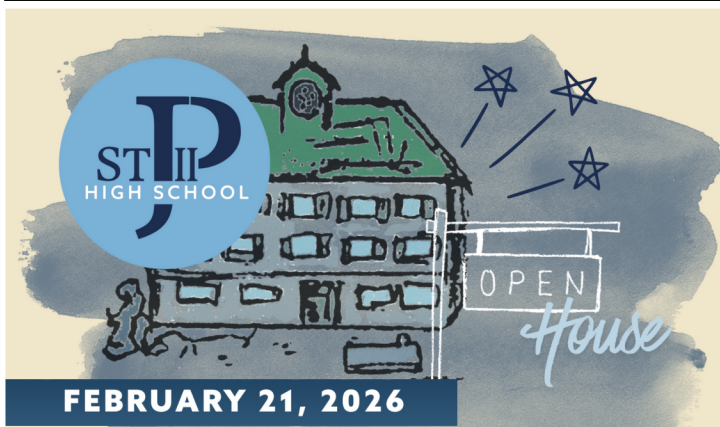

We invite all young adults (18+) to register as a parishioner. If you are still registered under your parents, or if you have recently moved here, now is the time to register.

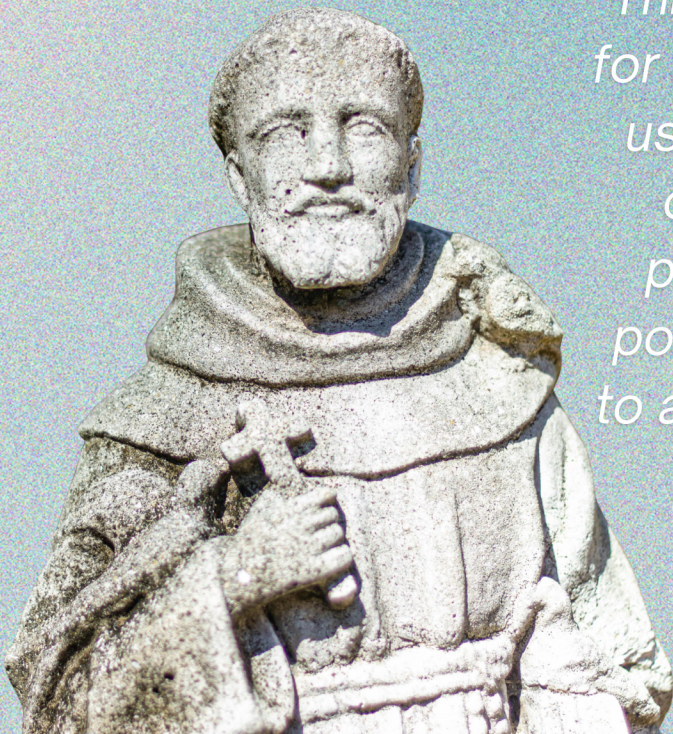

Our Lady of Lourdes appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858 in Lourdes, France, identifying herself as the Immaculate Conception. Through these apparitions, Mary called people to prayer, repentance, and trust in God's mercy. Lourdes has since become a place of pilgrimage and healing, known for the spring of water revealed during the apparitions. The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes is celebrated on February 11, a day when we pray in a special way for the sick and all who care for them.
