



PROTECT KIDS COLORADO PETITIONS UPDATE

We did it! Thanks to the Catholic Parishes across Colorado as well as public at large, we secured the signatures required to have the following initiatives on the ballot in November:

- #108 - Children are not for Sale Act (stiff penalty for child sex trafficking)
- #109 - Protect Women and Girls Act (no biological boys in girls sports)
- #110 - Protect Children from Irreversible Sex Surgery Act (no surgery before 18)

Next step - make sure to vote in November to ensure these initiatives are made into law in Colorado.
