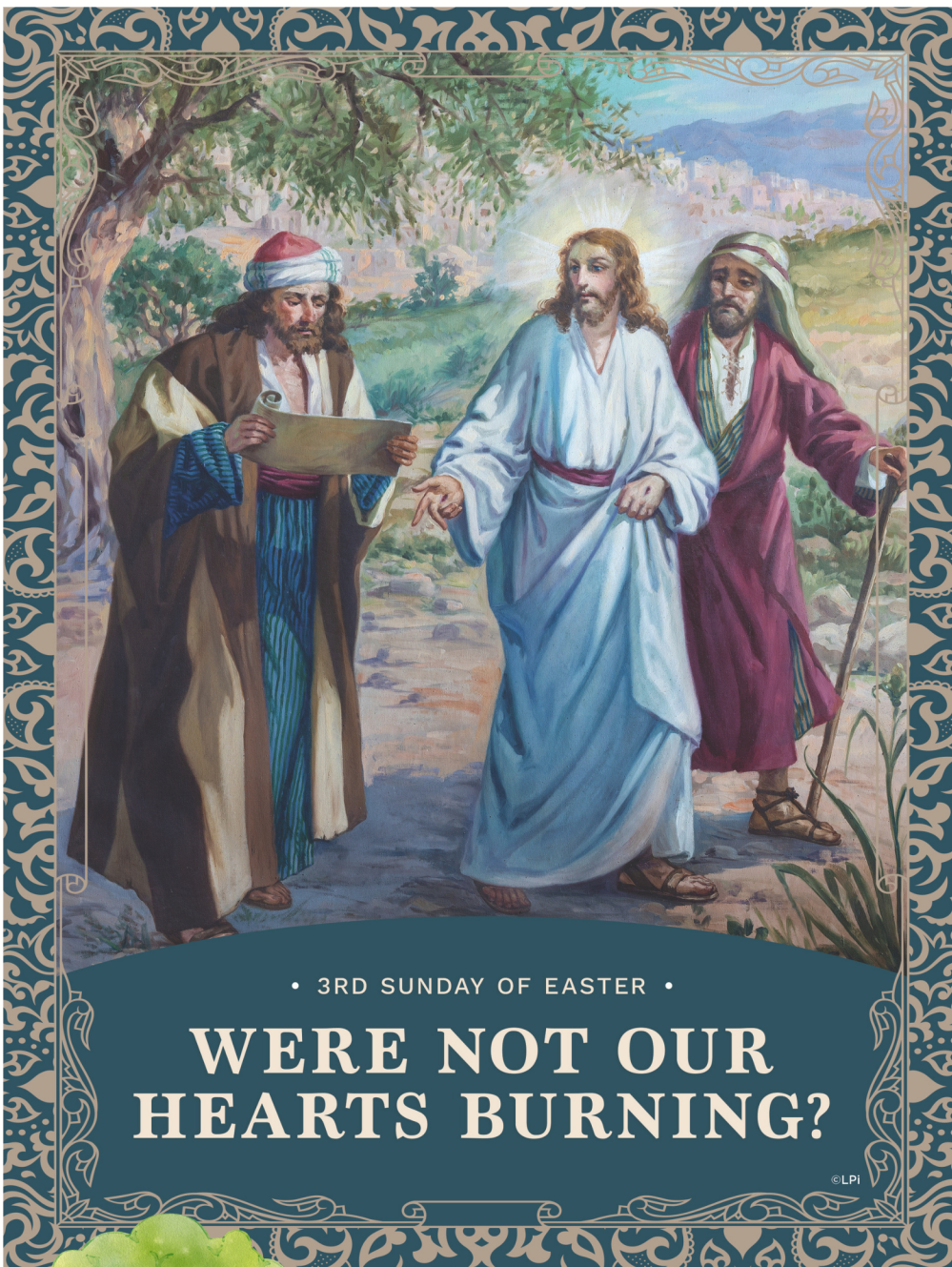

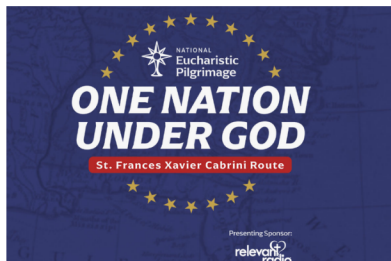


## CALLED BY NAME
