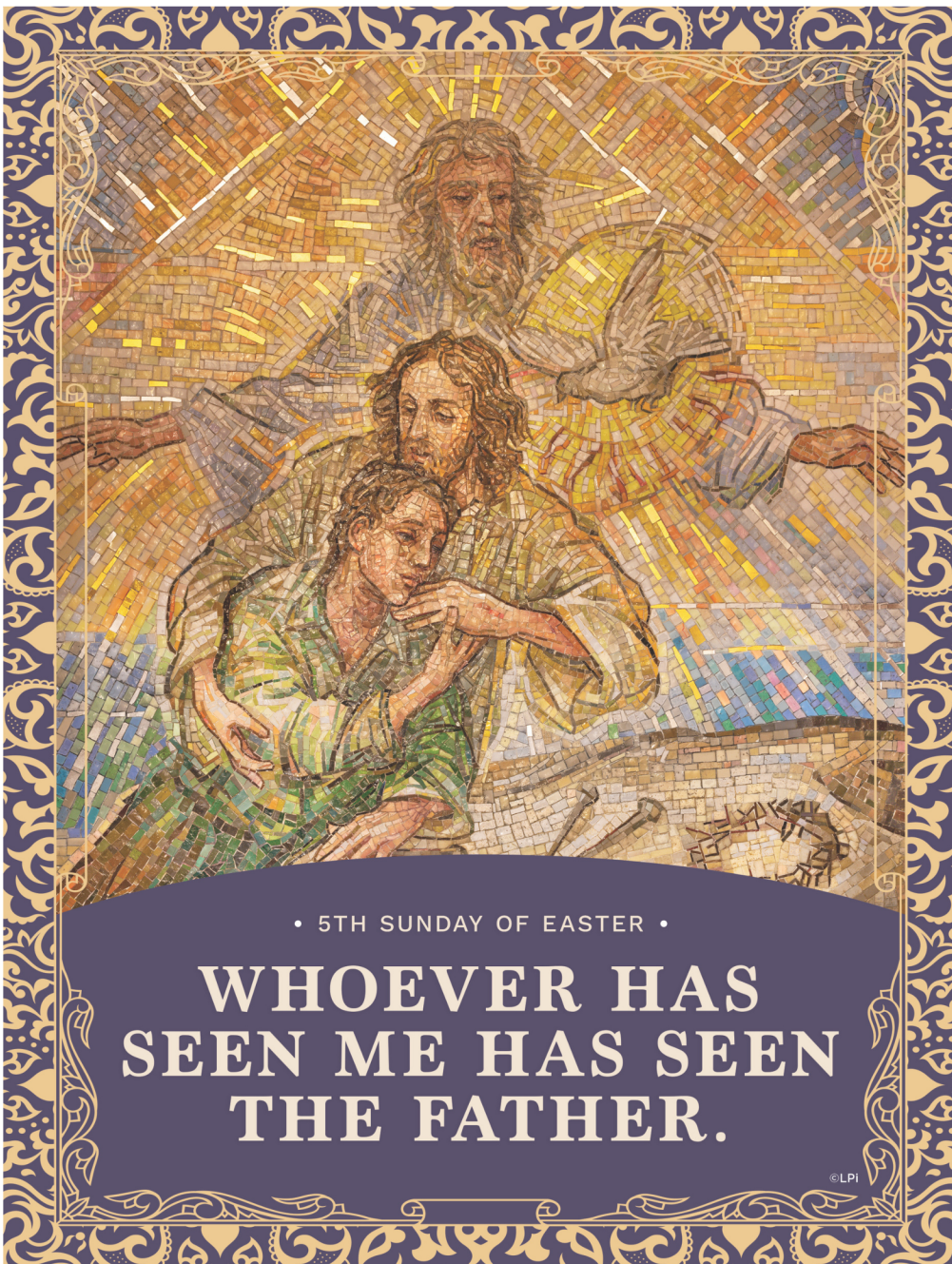

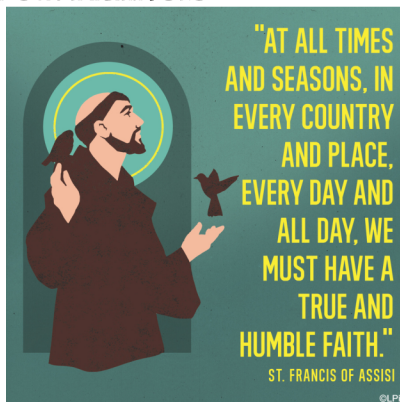
NOTEWORTHY
