**EASTER CANDLE**

The Easter Candle will be extinguished at the 5:00 p.m. Mass today, May 24. In the Catholic tradition, the Paschal (Easter) Candle is a symbol of the risen Christ, lit at the Easter Vigil and burning throughout the Easter season as a sign of His presence among us. Its extinguishing at the conclusion of the Easter season marks the Church's transition back into Ordinary Time, while reminding us that Christ's light continues to live in the hearts of the faithful.

The Easter Candle will continue to be lit at funerals and baptisms, where it signifies Christ's victory over death and the new life given through baptism.
